Cookies and Similar Technologies Policy

At InterDuels, we want to be transparent about how our website and app work. This policy explains what technologies we use, what we use them for, and how you can control them.

1. What does this policy cover?

This policy applies to the interduels.com website and the InterDuels mobile app (iOS and Android). It covers cookies, local storage, third-party SDKs, device identifiers, notification tokens, and any similar technology we use to ensure the services function properly.

It should be read together with our Privacy Policy, Legal Notice and General Terms of Use, available in the website footer.

2. What are cookies and similar technologies?

Cookies are small text files that a website saves in your browser. They are used to remember your session, your preferences, or how you use the service.

In the mobile app, we use equivalent technologies: SDKs embedded in the app code, local device storage (AsyncStorage), operating system-generated identifiers, and push notification tokens. These technologies are not HTTP cookies, but they perform similar functions and are subject to the same principles of transparency and control.

3. Categories we use

Necessary

They are essential for the website and app to function. Without them, you wouldn't be able to log in, access the dashboard, make payments, or use basic features. They don't require your consent because there is no alternative way to provide the service.

These include: session management and authentication, security, gym panel access, payment processing (Stripe), and system technical communications.

Preferences

They remember settings you've chosen, such as your language or privacy settings within the app. If you disable them, some options may not be remembered between sessions.

Analytics

They help us understand how the website is used: which pages are visited, how much time is spent in each section, and whether there are errors or bottlenecks. We use this information to improve the user experience, not for advertising.

On the website, we use Vercel Analytics and Vercel Speed Insights, which are only activated if you accept this category. In the app and backend, we use PostHog (pseudonymized product analytics) and Sentry (detection and management of technical errors), which operate under legitimate interest with data minimization.

Marketing

We do not currently use cookies or marketing/advertising pixels. If we activate campaigns in the future, this policy will be updated, and they will only be activated with your prior consent.

5. How to manage your preferences

On the web

When you visit interduels.com for the first time, a banner appears allowing you to accept, reject, or configure each category separately. You can change your choice at any time via the [Configure cookies](#) link in the footer.

The necessary technologies cannot be deactivated from the panel because they are essential for the service to function.

In the app

The app requests operating system permissions (notifications, location, camera, or gallery) only when it needs them for a specific function. You can change these permissions at any time from:

- iOS: Settings > InterDuels
- Android: Settings > Applications > InterDuels > Permissions

You can also manage your communication and privacy preferences from the app's internal settings.

From the browser

You can configure your browser to block or delete cookies. Please note that blocking necessary cookies may prevent access to some features of the web panel. Here are the configuration links for the most common browsers:

6. Suppliers and international transfers

Some of the providers we use are based or process data outside the European Economic Area. In all cases, we ensure that appropriate safeguards are in place.

7. How long do we keep the information?

Session cookies are deleted when you close your browser or app. Persistent cookies and analytics data are retained for the time indicated in the table in section 4, and never longer than necessary for their purpose.

Consent records are kept for as long as necessary to demonstrate regulatory compliance.

8. Updates to this policy

We will update this policy when we change the technologies we use, add new providers, or when applicable regulations change. If the changes are significant, we will notify you through the website or app.

Before we activate any new advanced analytics technology, marketing pixels, or social media SDKs, we will update this policy and, where appropriate, request your consent.
